Under "Indradhanush" National Level Online Event, Mathematics Quiz was oragnised on 16th May 2020 in which 11 teams participated.


A National Webinar entitled "Recent Trends and Application of Fixed Point Theory" on 19th June 2020. 172 participants enhanced their knowledge.




