

Students Feedback

Feedback is an essential part of learning effectively and enhancing student's learning experiences. Student feedback has become a widely used method to evaluate and improve teaching effectiveness. Feedback from your students allows us to know what we are doing that facilitates learning but, also what adjustments that need to be made. Even minor changes in the classroom can make a huge difference!

Students have a unique perspective of how their teachers educate. Obtaining student feedback allows the students to actively become more engaged and involved in the classroom. Student feedback can be collected cheaply and quickly, which gives teachers the opportunity to make any adjustments to their teaching as quickly as possible.

The feedback obtained from the students in the year 2020-21 is analyzed with the help of various tools and techniques and arranged in the form of table 1. The responses of the students were taken on a four-point scale i.e. 1 to 5. The rating provided to various parameters is based on their mean scores and categorizes as follows: Always ($4 \leq \text{M.S.} \leq 5$), Often ($3 \leq \text{M.S.} \leq 4$), Sometimes ($2 \leq \text{M.S.} \leq 3$), Rarely ($1 \leq \text{M.S.} \leq 2$) and Never ($\text{M.S.} < 1$).

Table 1 given below shows that all the parameters i.e. 12 upon which the students' feedback is obtained are rated as 'Always' which clearly signifies that students are satisfied with all aspects related to college and teachers.



It can be examined from the results that the mean score of all the parameters is above 4. The highest mean score i.e. 4.91 is obtained by parameter “Teacher completed the syllabus” and the lowest score i.e. 4.09 is obtained by the parameter ‘Use of Audio-Visual Aids’.

Whether the teacher was punctual in class?



Whether the teacher completed the syllabus?



Did the teacher organized Group Discussions, Debate, Role Play, Assignment, Periodical tests etc. in the class?



Did the teacher made use of Audio-Visual Aids in the Class?



Did the teacher resolve the problems related to the topic covered in class?



Did the teacher provide additional study material, notes and reference books?



Whether the teacher was audible, polite and sympathetic in class?



Did the teacher made available to you E-contents related to syllabus?



Teacher was well-versed in delivering online lectures.



Did the teacher take extra class for teaching, giving tests etc.?





It can be examined through the table 2 that students were satisfied with all the parameters i.e. 16 included in the Students satisfaction survey form as their mean score is greater than 3. The highest mean score was obtained by parameter ‘Quality of Teaching-Learning Process i.e. 3.52 which indicates that most of the students were satisfied with the quality of the teaching- learning process and the efforts put in by teachers of college during the year 2020-21 and whereas the lowest score was obtained by the parameter ‘Amenities provided at Cafeteria/Tuck-shop and others i.e. 3.01 which will further motivate us to enhance the services and amenities in the interest of the students.

How do you rate the overall quality of Teaching-Learning process?



How do you rate Time-table for your classes?



How do you rate teaching with the Use of ICT Tools?





How do you rate the co-curricular activities/ Sports facilities in the college and encouragement provided by the teachers to you to participate in these activities?





How do you rate the Internal Evaluation System of the college and follow up approach by teachers afterwards?



How do you rate your mentor / mentoring system in college to facilitate you in cognitive, social and emotional growth?



How do you rate the Library/ E-resources?



How do you rate the amenities provided at Cafeteria/Tuck-shop and others?



How do you rate the opportunities for experiential learning provided by different cells/clubs/societies?



How do you rate the coaching and training provided by the college for the respective sports?



How do you rate the infrastructure and equipments for outdoor/ indoor sports ?



How do you rate the practice session/ camps organised prior to the different tournaments?



How do you rate the financial incentives/assistance provided to you by the college?



Alumni Feedback

To the outside world, Alumni are the best ambassadors' of our college as their success and achievements represents concrete outcomes made by our college for them. The feedbacks of alumni were obtained for the year 2020-21 and analyzed with the help of various statistical tools which is presented in a tabulated form i.e. Table 3 The responses of alumni were taken on a five-point likert scale i.e. 1 to 5 where, 1 represents Unsatisfactory, 2 represents Satisfactory, 3 represents Fair, 4 represents Good and 5 represents Very Good. The parameters were rated on the basis of their mean scores so calculated and the criterion is as follows: Very Good. ($4 \leq M.S. \leq 5$), Good ($3 \leq M.S. < 4$), Fair ($2 \leq M.S. < 3$), Satisfied ($1.5 \leq M.S. < 2$) and unsatisfactory ($M.S. < 1.5$).

How do you rate the admission Procedure in the college?



How do you rate the environment/ ambience of the College for the overall development of the students?



How do you rate the adequacy of Infrastructure / Lab Facilities/Library etc. for contributing in the teaching learning process during your tenure in the college ?







Quality of other facilities like cafeteria, Tuck Shop etc. in the college?



Adequacy of know-how (both in theory and practice) provided at college?



How do you rate the Network of Alumnae Association maintained by college?



How do you rate the learning experience in terms of their relevance to the real life application?



Out of 199 responses, 55.8 per cent alumnae rated as very good. The rating of “good” and “fair” was given by 33.7 and 7 per cent alumnae. While 2.5 per cent alumnae rated as “satisfactory” and 1 per cent alumnae rated as unsatisfactory.

The parameters were rated on the basis of their mean scores so calculated and the criteria is as follows: Strongly Agree ($4 \leq M.S. \leq 5$), Agree ($3 \leq M.S. \leq 4$), Neither Agree nor Disagree ($2 \leq M.S. \leq 3$), disagree ($1.5 \leq M.S. \leq 2$) and strongly disagree ($M.S. < 1.5$).
































The feedback of 121 Parents/Guardians were obtained for the year 2020-21 and analyzed with the help of various statistical tools which is presented in a tabulated form i.e. Table 5 The responses of Parents/Guardians were taken on a five-point Likert scale i.e. 1 to 5 where, 1 represents poor, 2 represents fair, 3 represents good, 4 represents Very good and 5 represents excellent. The parameters were rated on the basis of their mean scores so calculated and the criteria is as follows: excellent ($4 \leq M.S. \leq 5$), Very good ($3 \leq M.S. \leq 4$), good ($2 \leq M.S. \leq 3$), fair ($1.5 \leq M.S. \leq 2$) and poor ($M.S. < 1.5$).

It is evident from the table below that Parents/Guardians were extremely satisfied with all the parameters i.e. 12 included in Parents/Guardians Feedback form and rated all the parameters excellent as the mean score of all these parameters are above 4. The highest mean score i.e. 4.45 is obtained by parameter “the security arrangements and safety measure in the college” which shows that the parents were satisfied with the security arrangements for the well being of their wards. The parameter “the academic discipline in the college i.e. timely conduct of lectures, practical’s conducted and related activities” stood second with a mean score of 4.37.

















How you will rate the use of ICT (Information and communication technology) in the college for accelerating the pace of teaching learning environment ?






